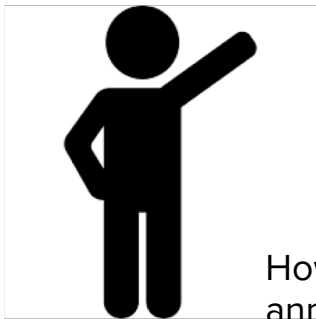




# What is SDSN Youth?

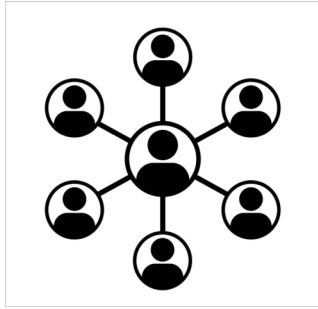

To transform the world's universities into [hubs of learning and engagement](#) for the SDGs, as well as [drivers of new solutions](#) to local problems.

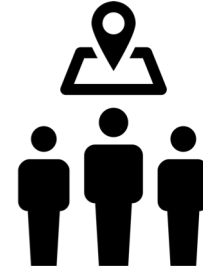
